

Smithville Lake Route

Construction Priority: First



This 14.53-mile, off-road trail with separate hard surface for shared use trail users is in the Smithville Lake Park area. The trail encompasses dam/bridge crossings, scenic views around the lake and provides experiences through dense woods and across streams at the lake's periphery. Suitable for all levels of users, this route capitalizes on the water resource constructed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
