

# Liberty/Holt via CB&Q Rail Line

Construction Priority: Third



This 15.34-mile shared use/equestrian route on hard and soft surface is within, what is now, Burlington Northern Santa Fe right-of-way. Good destinations are at either end with links to other Clay County destinations. Although the terrain is primarily flat, the experience to the trail user is one of wooded to open, agricultural to subdivision development and entry into a commercial district. The highlight of this trail is crossing Fishing River Greenway prior to entering Kearney and continuing on to Holt. This route terminates at Clay County's northernmost boundary.
