

# Clay County Line (North)/ Mosby via 69 Hwy.

Construction Priority: Third



This 11.78-mile on-road, hard surface, paved shoulder along U.S. Highway 69 begins northwest of Lawson and runs south to Excelsior Springs and continues along U.S. Highway 69 to Mosby. Hilly terrain with stream crossings is common north of Excelsior Springs. The trail offers connections to Watkins Mill State Park, Rocky Hollow Lake and Tryst Falls Park via trail corridors on Highway 92 and Old Quarry Road.
