

# Excelsior-Clay County Line via Hwy 92



Construction Priority: Third

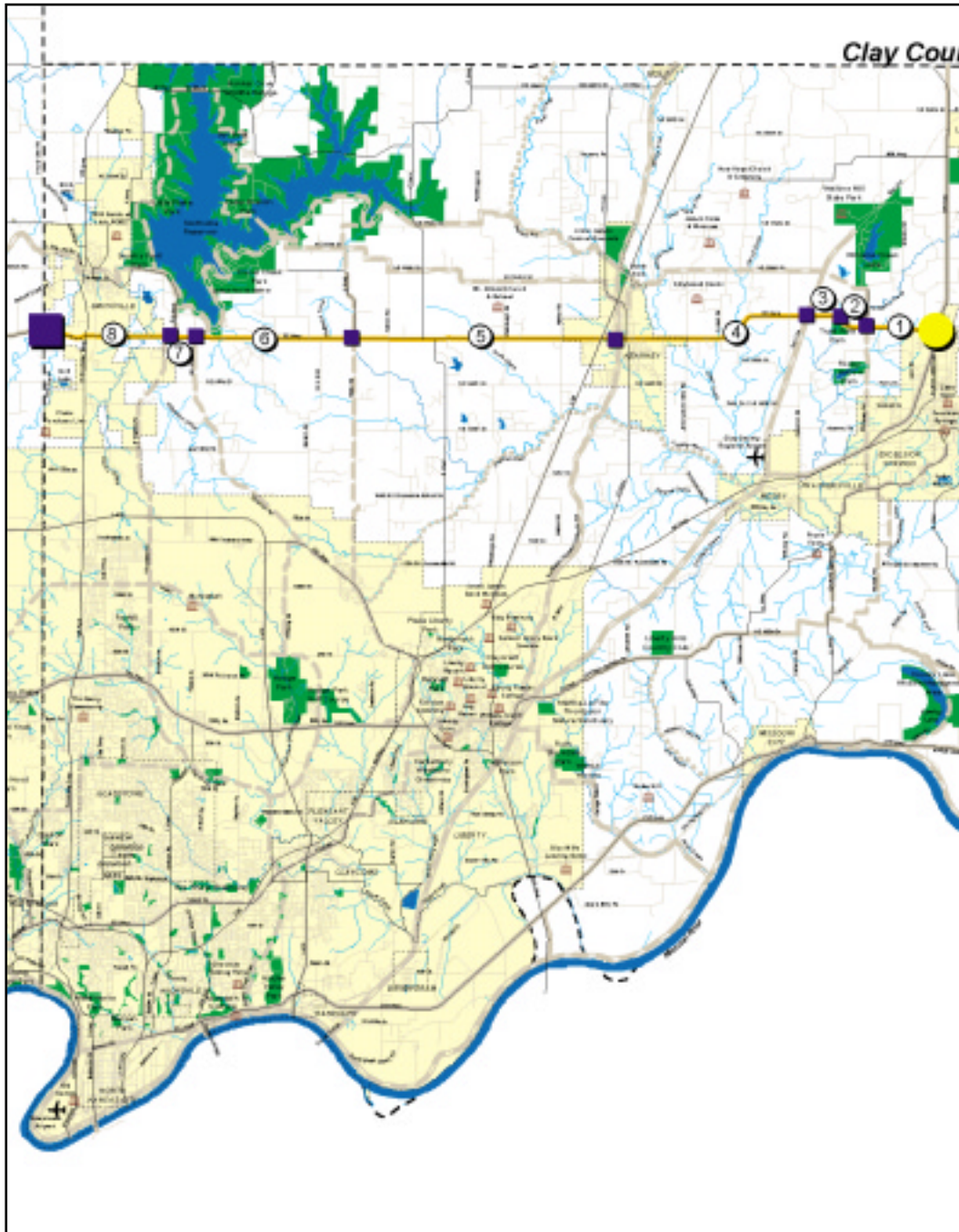
This 20.3 mile, on-road, hard surface, improved shoulder begins in Excelsior Springs at U.S. Highway 69 and travels west along Highway 92 where it crosses the Old Quarry Road shared use trail. From there, the trail runs past Tryst Falls Park,

crosses the Chicago Rock Island combined use trail and enters Kearney. In Kearney, the trail crosses BNSF Railroad combined use trail corridor, heads west to Stark Road shared use trail and enters Platte County west of Smithville.
