

Liberty-Clay/Platte County Line via Hwy. 152

Construction Priority: Third



This 10.95 mile, on-road, hard surface, improved shoulder on Highway 152 runs from William Jewell College to the Platte/Clay County line. Being a heavily traveled highway with multiple on and off ramps, this route will require an experienced rider. Riders begin the route at the Liberty Square. Many historical sites such as the Fairview Cemetery and the Liberty Arsenal are within minutes of this route. Traveling east, bicyclists encounter Hodge Park and can travel a few blocks south to the historical Barry Community site.
