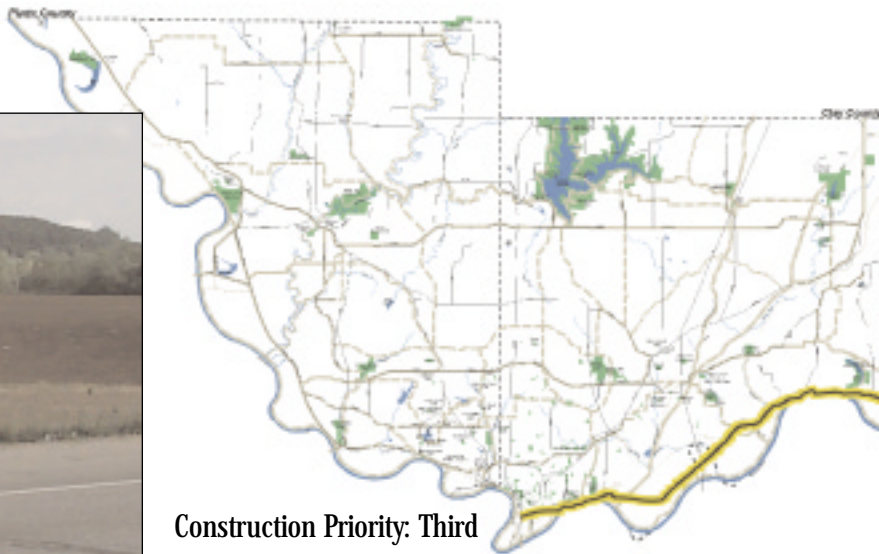


North Kansas City/County Line via Hwy. 210



Construction Priority: Third

This 22.41-mile on-street, hard surface, bike lane and paved shoulder begins in North Kansas City and goes east along 210 Highway to the Clay/Ray County Line. This route requires an experienced rider, as they will experience heavy traffic and multiple on and off ramps. The first segment is comprised

mainly of an urban environment but then quickly changes to a more agrarian setting with sweeping floodplains and forested hillsides. The Blue Mills Landing Battle site and Nebo Hill are two historical sites that are nearby. Cyclists will pass Cooley Lake while traveling east to the trail's end at the Clay/Ray county line.
