

Kearney - Smithville Lake via Clear Creek

Construction Priority: Second



This 12.77-mile, off-road, hard surface, shared use trail and off-road, soft surface, equestrian trail runs from Watkins Mill to Smithville Lake adjacent to Clear Creek. As users leave Kearney, they will follow Clear Creek as it winds its way through wooded hillsides. The trail enters the Smithville Lake area and joins with an existing equestrian trail system down to the Crow's Creek Area where it terminates. Trail users can access campground areas nearby and hikers and bicyclists can make use of the trail that skirts the perimeter of the lake.
