

Platte River Route



Construction Priority: Second



This 36.06 mile, off-road, soft surface, equestrian trail follows the Platte River from the Kendzora Conservation Park through the Platte Falls Conservation Area. Agricultural land comprises the majority of the trail as the user heads southwest to the Missouri River. Platte City is approximately half way between the trail's beginning and end and serves as a good destination point. Riverview Park provides a nice elevated viewshed of the area. The trail will drop in elevation approaching Farley and travel through floodplain farmland to the Missouri River.
