

Platte City Loop



Construction Priority: Third

This 18.42-mile on-road, paved shoulder on hard surface leaves Platte City near Harrel Ferrel Park and heads northwest on J Highway to Weston Bend State Park. The user will cross, Bee Creek in route over rolling terrain intermingle with wooded and agricultural land. The trail goes through Beverly, across Highway

45 and continues on through flood plain areas surrounding Mud Lake. Cross back over Highway 45 and head east on Humphrey's Access Road across the Platte River to Highway N. Travel north through residential development and into Platte City to complete this looped route.
