Construction Priority: First/Third

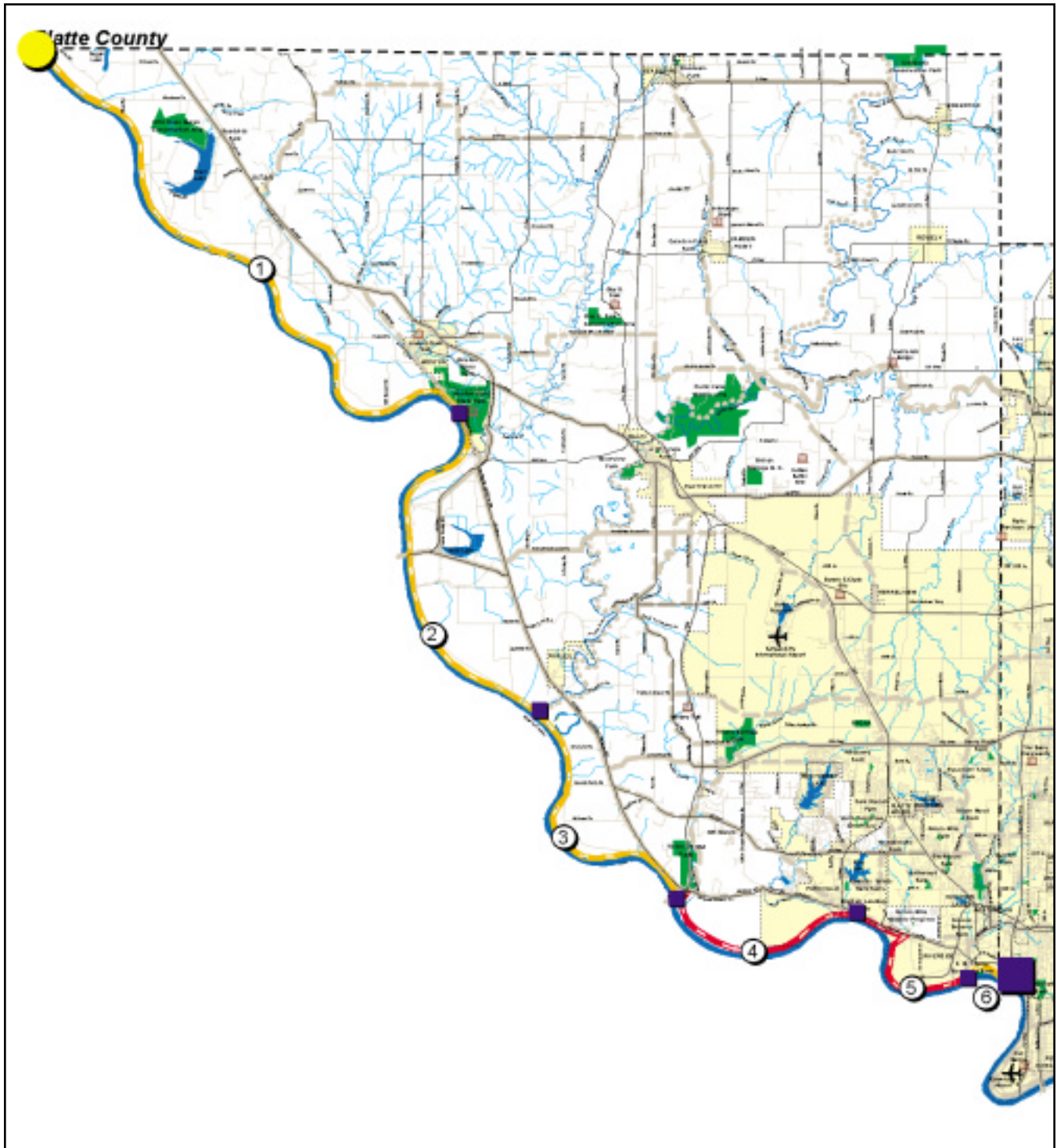


This 48.41 mile, off-road trail with separate facilities for shared use and equestrian is parallel to the Missouri River in its entirety as it runs from Riverside to the northwest to the Platte County/Buchanan County Line. Points of interest along the way include Parkville, Weston and the Little Bean Marsh Conservation Area.
