Clay County is creating a memorial to the soldiers who have died in service to their country from the time of the Civil War to the present. We received a list of names from Clay County of those men who have died in action and whose names will be inscribed upon the memorial statue. Our responsibilities included researching each name and verifying that a) they died in service to their country and b) that their name is spelled correctly for the memorial. We had determined that each name required two independent sources of verification, in order to ensure that no mistakes are made. To locate this information it was necessary to spend much time searching through public documents at local archive resources and also through the federal government's archive databases. Initially we were given a list of a little over 300, most of which dated back to the Civil War.

Upon starting the project, we came to a quick realization that the task assigned to us would require much more digging than we had originally anticipated. First, we began researching the Civil War at the local Clay County Archives. At the archives, we came across many sources, most of which proved fairly beneficial. However, especially with the Civil War, we came to realize that many people before us had attempted to do the very thing that we were now endeavoring to accomplish. Many names were simple and the spelling fairly easy to verify, however, there were many that were not. We attempted to dismiss the secondary sources, such as other historians' own lists, in favor of those which were more first hand and hopefully more reliable, such as family histories and document the soldiers had signed themselves (most of which were found at the National Archives and Records Administration – NARA). We also used databases online to determine cavalry or regiment numbers and then took those to look up the muster rolls. After exhausting all of these avenues, we then turned to more secondary sources, such as lists published in newspapers, by other historians and books. Initially we required that each name should have at least 2 primary sources matching the name given and using those standards we verified approximately 100 of the 203 names given. As time went on, we found it necessary to lessen the standards, due to the inadequate records kept at the time. However, we are confident that most of the names genuinely reflect the spelling of the name at that time.

We then moved on to World War I, which proved a large relief for a number of reasons. Firstly, the number of Clay County citizens that died in WWI was substantially less than the Civil War. The list we were given had 19 names, most of which were easily verifiable due to the significant interest in the war and pride associated with fighting in it. There were numerous tributes available and a book printed by the draft board once the conflict ended, with all the names and histories of the war dead. To that list we added one more casualty, which brought the total to 20.

Our next list was World War II. Our initial list included 148 war dead. Initially, we were a little disheartened to learn that government war records are sealed for about 70 years and that WWII records would not be released until after 2017. Therefore, we were required to be a little more industrious and had to locate sources from other locations. We located a book that contained WWII newspaper clippings, which included lists of the war dead at the time. We also came across another source that helped us tremendously. The Clay County Archives kept a record of obituaries and had them indexed. We also began to come across some internet sources that proved very helpful. Many organizations have

attempted to keep numerous records online for public viewing. We also, having come across an article that discussed a plaque dedicated to WWII deaths, researched a bit and found it at the local VFW station.

We next moved on to Korea and Vietnam. Korea had 2 war dead and Vietnam had 35. Nothing dealing with Vietnam was stored at the NARA and the Clay County Archives also had very little. Therefore, we turned to the internet yet again. The NARA has numerous online databases dealing with records from Korea and Vietnam. We used many lists, including casualty lists and general enlistment documents. Using these sources, we were able to verify most of the names given. It is also interesting to note that both WWI and WWII had many obituaries to be found, but Korea and Vietnam had none. The Gulf War had one casualty named Scott Speicher, which did not really need to be verified due to the public nature of his capture and possibly his containment in Iraq.

For most lists, we found additional names to add onto our original list. These names were either initially looked over or not known. We have provided these lists to our sponsors and they will take them and make the final decisions on who they feel should be included. For each additional name, we did the same research as our original and attempted to verify its authenticity and spelling. We had some names on the list that we could not verify in any way, most of which were with the Civil War and a few with Vietnam. We have provided all of this information to our sponsors and they will do with it what they see fit.

We are very appreciative for the opportunity we have been given to do research this summer. With the guidance of Dr. Chatlos and Dr. Spletstoser, we have had much experience working with primary documents, archives, online archives, microfilm and almost any type of information gathering that you can think of. Researching numerous leads, we ended up using 35 sources in our work. We have also become more acquainted with not just the history of Clay County but the history of our country. We have felt the sacrifice of war, if only for a brief moment, with each name we explore. We do not honor war itself or warriors, but men. We honor the sacrifice of the self for a higher purpose, knowing that these deaths were not isolated events without an impact but catastrophic to every person they affected. This having been said, we have done our best to ensure that the names inscribed on this memorial are as accurate as possible, for we both feel like we have invested our time and energy into something of extreme significance.
